

16 NABBED IN CRACKDOWN

Wayne County Sheriff's deputies have arrested **16** people so far **in** two days of a three-day **crackdown** on crime **in** Detroit's Virginia Park neighborhood.

Dubbed Project CRUSADERS (Crime Reduction Utilizing Statistical Analysis, Data Evaluation, and Response Strategies), Sheriff Warren Evans called the effort, which began Tuesday and ends Thursday night, "super saturation."

The arrests included a man suspected of running a drug house and six men who are accused of soliciting prostitution.
