

Detroit police search for suspect in August slaying

DETROIT -- Investigators are looking **for** a 23-year-old man **in** connection with a fatal shooting that left three other people injured.

Detroit Police said Aaron Jeron Montgomery pulled up to a home on the 15000 block of Birwood on Aug. 23 and opened fire. A 26-year-old man died **in** the shooting, **police** said.

Montgomery was last seen March 20 near Kentucky and Puritan on the city's northwest side. He was driving a green Dodge minivan and wearing a blue New York Yankees jacket and black jeans.

He is about 6 feet tall and weighs 185 pounds. Montgomery has a low-cut afro and a light beard.

Police said Montgomery is armed and considered dangerous. Those who see him should call homicide investigators at (313) 596-2260 or Crime Stoppers at (800) SPEAK-UP.
