

DETROIT: ARREST WARRANT ISSUED FOR SUSPECT IN TRIPLE SHOOTING

Detroit police are searching for a 29-year-old Detroit man they say they believe was involved in a triple shooting on the city's east side last week that left two people dead and one injured.

Police said Saturday that an arrest warrant has been issued for **Lakari Berry** , who also goes by the alias James Morgan III.

The shootings took place Thursday at an apartment complex on Gravier Street near Cadieux Road.

Police said two men burst into an apartment about 4:15 p.m. and bound two women - ages 17 and 18 - with duct tape. Both were shot.

Karisa Rice, 18, died, and the 17-year-old, whose name was not released, is in critical condition.

A man, 35-year-old Clarence Cherry of Detroit, was chased by one of the men as he ran from the apartment. He was shot at least 15 times and died at the scene.

According to the Michigan Department of Corrections Web site, the man known as both **Berry** and Morgan became a parole absconder in 2005 on felony firearms sentences.
