

Cops foil robbers after service

DETROIT -- Three police officers returning from the funeral for Officer Neil Wells proved Tuesday how quickly duty calls.

Officers David Hanesberry, **Carl Mack** and Romel Randolph nabbed four men suspected of robbing a Comerica Bank on Warren minutes after the funeral ended.

The arrests happened after the officers spotted one man ripping his clothes off in a blue cloud from an exploding dye pack, which banks place inside bags of money. Also arrested were two alleged lookouts and another man who allegedly acted as a getaway driver, police said.

The abortive robbery attempt would have netted \$80.
