

### 3 JAILED IN FATAL SHOOTING OF TEEN

Three brothers were charged Thursday with killing a 13-year-old west side youth as they sought revenge against others in the neighborhood who had beaten them in a fight after a playfield basketball game.

Daniel Lenard Brown, 21; Henry Hillis Brown, 17, and Larry Donnel Brown, 22, each were charged with first-degree murder, four counts of attempted murder and one count of using a firearm during a felony.

The brothers, who live in the 3200 block of Clairmount, are charged with killing Curtis Baker, who was walking home Monday on LaSalle near Pingree after cutting a neighbor's grass.

WITNESSES TOLD police that Daniel and Henry Brown, who had been beaten in the fight after the basketball game on a nearby playfield, returned to the area with their brother, Larry, in a blue Maverick a short time later.

Witnesses said that all three fired guns toward a group they thought were the young men who had beaten them in the earlier fight.

Curtis, who lived in the 2400 block of Pingree, was the only one hit by the gunfire. He was hit in the head by a single gunshot.

Police arrested **Daniel Brown** on Monday night and arrested his two brothers Tuesday, according to Sgt. Ronald Stewart, who headed the investigation.

The three were arraigned Thursday before Detroit District Court Magistrate Vesta Svenson, who ordered them held in the Wayne County Jail without bond pending a June 5 preliminary examination.
