

Detroit man charged in Eastpointe salon shooting

EASTPOINTE -- A 28-year-old Detroit man was arraigned today on charges related to a fatal shooting this week at Wild Stylz Salon on Eight Mile.

Shannon Anderson is charged with assault with intent to murder, felony firearm and being a felon in possession of a firearm.

Judge Norene Redmond of the 38th District Court in Eastpointe ordered Anderson held without bond in the Macomb County Jail while he awaits a Jan. 30 preliminary examination.

Eastpointe Det. Lt. Leo Borowski said authorities are waiting for laboratory results from evidence collected at the scene and additional charges may be pending.

Anderson opened the salon just a few weeks ago. He turned himself into police Thursday night.

The shooting happened about 5:20 p.m. Monday inside the salon. When police arrived at the scene, a man met them in the parking lot with gunshot wounds to his arm and side. A second man lay dead inside the salon. Killed in the shooting was Stanley Rhymes, 30 of Detroit. Troy Christian, 40, of Southfield is the wounded man who met police.

Investigators recovered a revolver and a semi-automatic pistol at the scene. Anderson's Cadillac Escalade was still in the salon's parking lot when police arrived.

Anderson, 28, is on parole. He served eight years in prison for a 1996 armed robbery. He was released from prison in 2003, and the next year, he was arrested for possession of less than 25 grams of cocaine. He was fined \$500, and he returned to prison for parole violation. He was released May 10.
