

## **Detroiter guilty in murder of girl , 7**

DETROIT -- A **Detroiter** was found **guilty of** first-degree **murder** Tuesday **in** the slaying **of** a 7-year-old **girl** who was shot to death **in** her east side home over a dispute about a missing video game.

A jury convicted Ronald Brown, 42, **of** the **murder of** Deva White on Dec. 2, and six counts **of** attempted **murder in** the drive-by shooting.

Brown will be sentenced June 22, said Wayne County Assistant Prosecutor Maria Miller.

Homicide Lt. James Tolbert said the shooting stemmed from a weeklong dispute between two neighborhood families over a misplaced video game, which was later found under a couch **in** a neighbor's home.

Deva was killed while she was doing her homework on the couch **in** her living room.

Brown has previous convictions for drug possession and assault.
