

DETROITER CHARGED IN RAPE OF SCHOOLGIRL

A 26-year-old man was **charged** Sunday with one **of two rapes of** teenage girls on their way to Detroit high schools Friday morning.

Earle Weaver, **of** the 8200 block **of** Almont, was arraigned **in** 36th (Detroit) District Court on seven counts **of** first-degree criminal sexual conduct.

Weaver was **charged in the rape of** a 16-year-old Cass Technical High School student who was forced into a car at W. McNichols and Lawton by two men.

Rodney Williams, 24, **of** Detroit, was also named **in** the warrant but is being sought.

The girl told police the men forced her to commit a sexual act inside the car then took her to Weaver's home, where she was raped repeatedly.

Weaver was arrested Saturday. He entered no plea at his arraignment.

The second **rape** occurred when a man armed with a knife forced a 15-year-old Cooley High student into an alley at Fenkell and Ardmore and raped her. He is being sought.
