

## **Driver charged in death - Detroit man, 21, accused of murder of child hit by car**

DETROIT -- A 21-year-old man accused of murder in the traffic death of a child faces an Oct. 17 preliminary examination on the charge in 36th District Court.

**Rontae Hill** was arraigned on murder and other related charges Sunday in the death of 11-year-old Darrin Marshall last Wednesday. The boy was hit by a car as he stood on a sidewalk in front of his home.

Magistrate Robert Costello set **Hill** 's bond at \$350,000.

**Hill** was driving a stolen Ford Taurus at speeds in excess of 70 mph last Wednesday when he lost control of the car in the 20000 block of Andover and collided with a Ford Expedition, police said.

The impact slammed the Expedition into another car that hit the Nolan Middle School student.
