### 8 ALLEGED GANG MEMBERS INDICTED IN DRUG CASE

Eight alleged members of a Jackson drug gang have been charged in a 14-count indictment unsealed Tuesday in Detroit.

The indictment said the defendants are members of the **Evonnie Boyz & Gyrlz** gang and charged them with conspiring to distribute crack cocaine and heroin in Jackson during the past year.

The most serious charge, conspiring to distribute more than 50 grams of crack cocaine, carries 10 years to life in prison.

The eight were identified as: Deondre Mullen, 33; Sharonda Bailey, 23; Jarrell Fullilov, 24; Dwight Fullilov, 22; Dionte Reed, 20; Delano Tarpley, 19; Jamie Wagner, 20, and Deshawn Sweet, 20, all of Jackson.

Five defendants who appeared in court Monday and Tuesday are being held pending trial or detention hearings.

Tarpley is in state custody, and Bailey and Sweet are fugitives, authorities said.
