

## Man wanted for questioning in shootings

DETROIT -- A **man** who has been **wanted for** a narcotics-related murder since March 2006 is being sought by police as "a person of interest" **in** connection with the early Wednesday morning triple **shooting** on Winthrop **in** which two persons, including a pregnant **woman** , were killed.

Eric Deon Pippen, 24, is not considered a suspect at this time, said department spokesman, James Tate. The outstanding murder warrant against Pippen stemmed from a fatal **shooting** March 5, 2006.

**In** the incident Wednesday morning Lakeisha White, 34, who was eight months pregnant, and the father of her unborn child were fatally shot and a 25-year-old woman was wounded.
