Teen charged in deadly shooting

A 15-year-old Detroit boy has been charged as an adult with first-degree murder, attempted murder and robbery in the Aug. 25 shootings of three people in a west-side Detroit restaurant.

Erick Martin , who turned 15 the day after the shootings, is being held without bond pending a Sept. 24 preliminary examination in 36th District Court.

Martin , who has a minor police record for curfew violations but no convictions in juvenile court, is charged in the shootings of three people, including 18-year-old Darian Matthews, in the A Eagles Coney Island on Dexter near Joy Road. Matthews died of his injuries.

A restaurant security camera captured a gunman shooting Matthews and robbing him of his designer sunglasses. Two other teens were wounded in the gunfire.
