### Guilty in 3 slayings

DETROIT -- A Recorder's Court jury found Detroitier Timothy Kincaid **guilty** Tuesday of three counts **in** the 1978 shotgun and pistol **slayings** of three persons on the city's northwest side.

Kincaid, 20, faces mandatory life **in** prison. Judge Richard Hathaway scheduled sentencing May 5.

Barbara Henton, who was wounded **in** the attack, had testified from a wheelchair that she saw Kincaid with a shotgun moments before Sheron Burrell, Pamela Lewis and Stephanie Ellington died **in** a small brick bungalow **in** the 15800 block of Ferguson.

After the verdict, Henton said, "This is my birthday today, and as far as this verdict being a present, it just shows that what goes around comes around. "

She said she and the other women were shot to eliminate witnesses to the killing of Burrell by his brother, Quincy Robinson. Robinson was convicted previously and killed **in** prison last month.
