

Hunt continues for suspect in double homicide

DETROIT -- Police still are looking **for** a 23-year-old man **in** connection with the fatal stabbing of his former girlfriend and her mother.

Detroit police investigators have named Walter Ramsey a **suspect in** the Friday slayings of Erica Martin and her mother, Kim Martin, **in** a home on the 4800 block of Townsend.

The 3-year-old son of Ramsey and Erica Martin was home at the time of the slayings. Police said he was unharmed and now is with relatives.

Police officials said the stabbings stemmed from a domestic incident but would not release more details.

Officials describe Ramsey as a black male, 5-foot-9, with a light complexion and thin to medium build.
