

2 ARE CHARGED IN SLAYING OF SCHOOLTEACHER IN N. ROSEDALE

Two men were arraigned Wednesday in the killing of a schoolteacher during a break-in at his North Rosedale Park home.

James Lee Johnson, 21, and **Eugene Posey**, 26, were charged with first-degree murder in the shooting death of Andre Poux.

Magistrate Thomas Shannon of 36th District Court ordered the two held without bond in the Wayne County Jail. They'll have a Dec. 14 preliminary examination.

Police say the two crashed through a rear door of the Poux home in the early morning of Nov. 25. When Andre Poux came downstairs to investigate, he was shot in the chest.

The murder charges against Johnson and **Posey** carry life sentences upon conviction. They also could receive life terms if found guilty in a robbery and rape that happened on the east side four days before the Poux killing.

Police linked the two cases because a flashlight taken in the earlier robbery was found at the Poux home.

On Nov. 21, also during predawn hours, two men broke into a West Village home on Seyburn.

As the husband was held at gunpoint, one of the men raped the wife.

The two left the home with cash, jewelry, televisions and a stereo.

Both men were charged with robbery and breaking and entering. Johnson has been charged with rape.
