Authorities nab man suspected in Macomb bank robberies

MACOMB COUNTY — The FBI and Roseville Police Department have arrested a man alleged to have been involved in a serial bank robberies in Macomb County.

Jimmie Lee Fortune, 28, of Detroit, was arrested Sunday afternoon and will be arraigned in U.S. District Court today, according to the FBI.

Authorities executed two federal search warrants, one of the suspect's home and one of the suspect's vehicle that was believed to have been used in the robberies.

Fortune is suspected to have robbed at least eight banks in the Macomb County, the latest on June 19 at a TCF Bank in Roseville.
