

Man arrested in shooting that hurt 11-year-old girl

DETROIT -- Police have arrested a 20-year-old man in the July 12 shooting of an 11-year-old girl on the city's southwest side.

Jose Eduardo Valencia-Deloca on Thursday, was named in an arrest warrant with charges of assault with intent to murder, assault with intent to do great bodily harm, felonious assault and being a felon in possession of a firearm. He was arrested earlier this week.

Police allege **Valencia-Deloca** argued with another man and opened fire on the 8000 block of Rathbone. A bullet grazed the girl's back as she walked down the street, police said. She survived the shooting.

It was unclear if the other man was injured.

A Crimestoppers tip led to **Valencia-Deloca** 's arrest, police said.
