

Cops capture one of Detroit's most wanted fugitives

DETROIT - A 22-year-old who was among Detroit's most wanted murder suspects for the past two years was arrested today by the Detroit police department's Repeat Offender Unit.

Juan DeJesus Rapley was apprehended in the 8800 block of Grand River. He was wanted for the May 25, 2005, death of a man who was gunned down as he was walking with a female companion in the area of Wildemere and Calvert. The woman was not hurt.

Rapley is charged with first-degree murder, assault with intent to murder, felon in possession of a firearm, felony firearm and felony firearm second offence, and habitual criminal third offence.
