

Man arraigned in Detroit sexual assault cases after mother takes him to police

DETROIT - A Detroit mother unwittingly assisted in the arrest of her son who was arraigned this afternoon in 36th District Court for several cases of criminal sexual assault and home invasion on the city's east side.

DeAndre Mullins, 29, was arrested by Detroit Police Saturday after surveillance video of him attempting to break into a home was made public, officials said. The man's mother saw the video and brought him to the Northeastern District on East Nevada to clear up suspicion of his involvement.

Mullins was identified by three of his victims as being the perpetrator. He also admitted to being recorded on the surveillance video. He is being held in Wayne County jail without bond.
