Man arrested in Detroit triple shooting

DETROIT — A 19-year-old man is expected to be arraigned today in 36th District Court on charges related to a triple murder in the city earlier this week.

Steven Todd Kennedy , was arrested by the Detroit Police Department's Violent Crimes Task Force and faces three counts of first-degree murder and three counts of armed robbery.

Police said **Kennedy** previously arranged with two unidentified suspects to rob the victims Verlon Hall, 20; Peter Christian, 20; and Ivan Dantzler, 25.

About 10:30 a.m. Monday, **Kennedy** was with the men at a home in the 18500 block of Prairie, near Seven Mile and Livernois, when he opened the door for two armed suspects. Demanding cash, the visitors shot the three men, police said. They and **Kennedy** then fled, police said.
