### MAN AWAITS SENTENCING ON U.S. DRUG CHARGES

A 25-year old Detroit man was convicted Thursday in U.S. District Court of possession with intent to distribute cocaine and marijuana, among other charges.

A jury deliberated about two hours before finding **John Roosevelt Miller** guilty.

He was arrested May 9, 2006, after Detroit police responded to complaints of drug sales around a home near Lindsay and 7 Mile Road. Seeing the officers, Miller ran and entered a home and barricaded himself inside.

Police officers with the department's Narcotics Street Enforcement Unit forced their way into the home and arrested Miller.

Miller faces from 10 to 12 years in prison. A sentencing date has not been set.
