Man charged with killing 16-year-old at gas station

A 47-year-old Detroit man accused of shooting to death a 16-year-old boy in Detroit last week has been charged.

Detroit Police said **William Reid** approached Javonta Henderson Thursday night at a gas station on Joy Road. Police said he demanded money he believed he was owed by the teen. Police said the two argued and Reid shot Henderson several times. Reid was charged during the weekend with felony murder, carrying a concealed weapon without a permit and using a firearm in the commission of a felony. He was denied bond.
