Man found guilty of killing daughter

A Wayne County jury **found** a Detroit **man guilty** but mentally ill in the fatal shooting **of** his 20-month-old **daughter**.

Antonio Ware, 24, faces mandatory life imprisonment for the death **of** his child, Amari Ware. Ware shot Amari on June 27 after arguing with Amari's mother, Victoria Seldon.

During the weeklong trial, psychologists who had evaluated Ware testified that he was mentally ill. The jury deliberated for two hours.

Robert Moran, the Wayne County assistant prosecutor who tried the case, said Ware will still face a life sentence with no chance **of** parole, but he has the option **of** getting treatment in prison. He will be sentenced on Dec. 10 by Wayne County Circuit Judge Annette Berry.
