

Man held in shooting is alleged drug kingpin - One of two charged in Southfield attack is wanted by FBI for alleged role in cocaine ring.

SOUTHFIELD -- One of two **men** arrested **in a shooting** this week **in** Southfield has been identified as a suspected **drug kingpin** wanted by the FBI for allegedly moving millions of dollars **in** cocaine across the U.S.

The federal fugitive, Michael L. Glanton Jr., 30, of Toledo was charged Thursday **in** Southfield 46th District Court with assault with intent to do great bodily harm less than murder and firearms offenses **in** the wounding of a 20-year-old **man** .

Glanton and Anthony Roshawn Lawrence, 22, of Detroit who was similarly charged, were arrested about 7 a.m. Wednesday after their Dodge Charger slammed into a Southfield patrol car near Southfield, south of Eight Mile, during a police chase.

The pair were arrested a short distance away and a third unnamed suspect was still sought.

Judge Susan Moiseev set bond at \$500,000 on Glanton and \$350,000 on Lawrence and ordered both **held in** the Oakland County Jail.

"There have been numerous significant arrests we've made **in** the last six months," Southfield Police Chief Joseph Thomas said. "You would think the criminal element would get the message to stay out of our city. Eventually, we will catch you and it won't be pretty."

Police say Glanton has been sought by authorities since April 2002 after a truck he was driving was impounded **in** Beaver County, Pa. While Glanton was released, a search of the truck later turned up 12 kilograms of cocaine **in** hidden compartments, police said.

A Pennsylvania warrant for Glanton's arrest was issued for possession with intent to deliver, criminal conspiracy and corrupt organizations.

A federal fugitive warrant was later issued **in** U.S. District Court after a grand jury probe of a Phoenix-to-Beaver County **drug** pipeline that brought nearly \$22 million **in** cocaine into Pennsylvania **in** a two-year period.
