Man involved in weekend shooting could be arraigned today

DETROIT — A 22-year-old man could be arraigned as early as today in the weekend shooting that killed one teen, critically injured another and sent five others to area hospitals for treatment.

Orlando Robinson has been named in an arrest warrant with first degree murder, six counts of assault with intent to murder, being a felon in possession of a firearm, and felony firearms charges, Detroit police said in a press release.

A fight erupted about 12:30 a.m. Saturday involving two groups of young men outside of a rental hall on the 14100 block of Wyoming, police said. Police allege Robinson pulled a gun and fired it several times, striking the victims.

Edward Jones, a 16-year-old Detroiter, died in the shooting. Another teen remains in critical condition. One of the shooting victims was 13 years old, police said.
