### MAN SOUGHT AFTER 2 SHOT NEAR SCHOOL

Detroit police are seeking a **man** for questioning in a double shooting near Central High **School** on Tuesday.

The victims - a 25-year-old **man** and an 18-year-old **man** - were standing near the **school** in the 2400 block of Tuxedo about 5:40 p.m. when they got into an argument with a third **man** . When the two turned to walk away, the third **man** opened fire, police said.

Police said the incident could be tied to a gang-related incident last week.

Both victims were taken to Henry Ford Hospital, where the 25-year-old **man** was in critical condition and the 18-year-old in serious condition. None of those involved are students at the **school** .

Also, police announced they picked up a **man** wanted for questioning in connection with the Monday morning shooting of a 17-year-old **man** at a gas station on the city's west side.

That shooting occurred about 7:30 a.m. in the 22700 block of Fenkell. The victim was **shot** in the abdomen and was in critical condition.

Police are questioning another 17-year-old **man** in the incident.
