

MAN HELD IN AFTER-HOURS CLUB KILLINGS - DETROITER CAUGHT SNOOZING IN STOLEN CAR, POLICE SAY

Detroit police have captured a suspect in a double murder at an after-hours club, they said Monday -- sleeping in a stolen car.

They found **Dalshan Peacock**, 20, of Detroit and his 19-year-old brother in the car in southwest Detroit, in the 7000 block of Sarene, about 7:30 a.m. Saturday, after someone called, police said. A license plate check showed the car was stolen.

The two men were arrested. Then, during the booking, police realized **Peacock** was wanted in the double slaying, said spokeswoman Eren Stephens. He was arraigned Monday in 36th District Court on two counts of first-degree murder.

Although a motive in the Jan. 7 killings of Kevin Johnson, 27, and Angelo Brandon, 32, at the Social Club on Detroit's west side is still unknown, police said Monday they were looking at **Peacock** as a suspect based on statements from witnesses.

"These homicides starkly illustrate the danger and violence that can happen in after-hours clubs," Wayne County Prosecutor Kym Worthy said.

The killings highlighted Detroit's ongoing problems with after-hours clubs - which county authorities promised to crack down on after shootings at the C.C.C. club last April left rapper Proof and another man dead.
