Man is charged in gas station killing

A 24-year-old Detroit man who may be linked to the fatal shooting of an armored car guard earlier this week has been charged in a warrant with first-degree murder in the shooting death Monday of a Sterling Heights man.

**Desmond Kenneth Krumsey** is expected to be arraigned today in 36th District Court in Detroit in the fatal shooting of Bobby Huffman, 25.

According to Detroit police, Huffman had stopped at a Citgo gas station at East Seven Mile and Hoover at about 9 p.m. Monday and purchased a beverage. When he returned to his car, a gunman approached, spoke to Huffman briefly and ordered him to run.

As Huffman ran, the gunman fired several shots, killing him, police said.

Homicide detectives said there is some evidence linking **Krumsey** to Wednesday's fatal shooting of Gerald Kikos, 36, of Eastpointe, an armored car guard ambushed by a masked gunman. A second guard, Tommie Scott, 29, was shot and critically wounded in the holdup attempt.

The Wayne County Prosecutor's Office is waiting for a Detroit police report before deciding whether anyone will be charged.

While investigating Kikos' killing, police recovered a cache of weapons in a home in the 14400 block of Burns.
