Mom begs : Help find baby's killer

The mother of a 4-month-old boy who was shot to death Sunday morning appealed to the public Monday to help find her son's killer.

Seleena Tafflemire, 25, described the moments before her son, Walter Bogan III, was shot as he slept in their apartment on Detroit's west side. Tafflemire said she got up at 4:30 a.m. to feed him and give him medicine, then brought him to the living room to watch a movie with her.

"My baby's done nothing to no one. I've done nothing to no one. My family has done nothing to no one," Tafflemire said.

"And somebody, I know you know something, and I know you may be scared. But I beg you: I beg you to please come forward."

Detroit City Council President Monica Conyers released a statement Monday that said she would support "enactment of a death penalty for anyone that kills a child in Michigan," according to Free Press reporting partner WDIV-TV Local 4.
