

Police arrest man in Georgia wanted for May slaying in Detroit

DETROIT -- The Atlanta FBI Fugitive Task Force on Friday arrested a 22-year-old Detroit **man** **in** connection with a **May** 7 fatal shooting.

Task force officers arrested James Duane Crawford **in Georgia** . The city where he was arrested was not released from **police** .

A tip led to the **arrest** , Detroit **Police** said.

Investigators believe that Crawford shot a 28-year-old Detroit **man** after an altercation with another person **in** the 11700 block of Hamilton.

Crawford was assaulting a woman and the other **man** intervened, **police** said. Crawford stopped his alleged attack and the other **man** entered a nearby gas station.

When the **man** came out of the station, Crawford allegedly berated him for interfering and shot him several times, Detroit **Police** said. Crawford fled on foot after the incident, Detroit **Police** said.

He is named **in** an **arrest** warrant on charges of first-degree murder and being a felon **in** possession of a firearm.

Crawford was on Detroit **Police** 's most **wanted** list and his picture was circulated on posters. He is the 27th person arrested as part of that program, which began **in** 2004.
