

RELATIVES COPE WITH DEATHS OF CHILDREN - MOTHER CHARGED AFTER MURDER, ABUSE OF KIDS

Relatives of Adonnis and Acacia **Maynor** went about the grim business of finalizing funeral arrangements Tuesday, even as a storm of national media attention crashed around them.

The two children -- 3 years old and 10 months -- died last week while locked in their mother's stifling black Neon in the parking lot outside a Southfield beauty salon.

Their mother, **Tarajee Shaheer Maynor**, 25, of Detroit, remains jailed without bond in Oakland County on two counts of felony murder and two counts of first-degree child abuse. She faces life in prison without parole if convicted of felony murder.

A preliminary examination conference is tentatively scheduled for July 10 in Southfield District Court.

The children's family hasn't returned telephone calls. Neither has **Tarajee Maynor**'s Bloomfield Hills attorney, Elbert Hatchett. And an attorney for the salon said it has been besieged with calls from media outlets across the country.

Meanwhile, arrangements for the children's funerals continued at James Cole Home for Funerals in Detroit. Visitation will be at the James Cole Northwest Chapel, on Puritan near Schaefer, from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. Friday. Similar hours on Thursday are possible.

The funerals will be held Saturday, with visitation beginning at 1 p.m. and services at 1:30 p.m.
