

SOUTHFIELD MAN MAY FACE 2ND SLAYING CHARGE

A **Southfield man** charged last week with the Detroit **slaying** of a go-go dancer is expected to be charged today Friday with strangling to death another go-go dancer, according to police officials.

Victor Malone, 38, was seen leaving different city topless go-go clubs with the women, who later turned up dead, investigators said.

Malone could be connected "with no more, or 15 more" unsolved **slayings** of women dating back as far as 1972, said a Detroit police official. Homicide investigators are examining files on about 50 unsolved murders to see if Malone might have been involved, said the official.

POLICE OFFICIALS today are expected to request a murder warrant against Malone that involves the July 1984 **slaying** of Anita Willis, 27, of the 2700 block of W. Grand Blvd. Malone is being held in Wayne County Jail in lieu of \$1 million bond.

Willis' nude body was found between the sidewalk and street in front of a home in the 2400 block of McLean on Detroit's east side about 6:30 a.m. on July 23 by a **man** on his way to work. The body had been dumped there, police said.

Willis was killed by "manual strangulation," a police spokesman said.

Detroit homicide Lt. Al Brooks, who is co-ordinating the Malone investigation, said the Willis case was "wide open, with no suspects" until police received an anonymous call last week after Malone's picture appeared in the newspaper.

Brooks said that the female caller said that on the night before Willis' body was found she was seen leaving the K-Club -- a private topless go-go club on Woodrow Wilson just south of Davison -- with a **man** who resembled Malone.

LAST FRIDAY, Malone was charged with the **slaying** of Leisha Brooks, 26, who was found Dec. 5 nude from the waist down, tied up, beaten and shot in the head in a room at the Woodward Motel. Brooks was seen leaving the Fancy Pants Lounge, a Highland Park topless go-go bar, with Malone the night before her body was found, police said.

Malone, has a criminal record that includes convictions for armed robbery, bank robbery, assault and a narcotics violation. Two recent sexual assault cases in Detroit were dismissed.

Malone served time in prison on the bank robbery **charge** . He has a master's degree in social work from the University of Michigan.

Malone, who apparently is unemployed, has been collecting state welfare payments for more than two years. The welfare payments have been sent to a Detroit home where one of Malone's relatives lives. The relative said Malone does not live there.

Brooks said anyone with information about deaths of prostitutes or go-go dancers -- "no matter where the body was found or the method of death" -- is asked to call the Detroit police homicide section at 224-4280 any time.
