

## Suspect arrested in Milt's Gourmet Barbecue murder

DETROIT - An 18-year-old employee at **Milt's Gourmet Barbecue** was charged Friday with the Aug. 25 slaying of Milton Goodson, the owner of the popular east-side eatery on Kelly Road.

A warrant charging Jeffery Gaskins of Detroit with felony **murder** was issued by Wayne County Prosecutor Kym L. Worthy. A 15-year-old suspected of being an accomplice was **in** police custody pending further investigation.

Goodson was as well-known as a civic leader and community benefactor as he was celebrated for turning out some of the best **barbecue in** the city. He and other employees had fled the restaurant as a gunman came through the back door after 10 p.m. Goodson was killed when he went back inside to check on a new employee who was left behind.

Gaskin was **arrested** Friday and was expected to be arraigned later **in** the day.
