

Suspect charged in slayings at after-hours club

DETROIT - **Dalshan** Kendrik **Peacock** , 20, of Detroit, was charged Monday with shooting to death two men in a west-side after-hour club earlier this month.

Wayne County Prosecutor Kym L. Worthy charged Kendrik with two counts of first-degree murder in the slayings of Kevin Johnson, 27, and Angelo Brandon, 32, at The Social Club, 12152 Dexter, in the early morning hours of Jan. 7.

Both victims were from Detroit.

Johnson was found in a bathroom with a gunshot wound in the head. Brandon's body was on the sidewalk with a gunshot wound in the chest.

"We have been consistently working with the Detroit Police Department and other agencies to close after hour clubs because of the problems they pose," Worthy said. "These homicides starkly illustrate the danger and violence that can happen in after hour clubs."

Peacock was also charged with two counts of felony firearm. The murder charges carry maximum penalties of mandatory life in prison without parole. The firearm charges have mandatory two-year sentences.

Peacock was arraigned on the charges Monday in 36th District Court in Detroit.
