

## DETROIT: TEEN IS ARRESTED IN FATAL SHOOTING

A 15-year-old Detroit boy **is in** the Wayne County Juvenile Detention Facility on murder, attempted murder and robbery charges **in** the Aug. 25 **shooting** of three people at a northwest-side restaurant, apparently to steal an expensive pair of sunglasses.

The **teen** , who appeared at a brief court hearing Wednesday, **is** being held without bond pending a decision by the Wayne County Prosecutor's Office on whether he will be charged as a juvenile or adult.

According to Detroit police, the incident happened about 11:30 p.m. at A Eagles Coney Island, 9122 Dexter near Joy.

According to a police report, the **teen** was sitting with four youths **in** the restaurant when Darian Matthews, 18, of Detroit entered with several friends to order food.

The 15-year-old got up, left the restaurant and walked around the parking lot. As Matthews was leaving, the **teen** went back **in** , approached Matthews and fired four shots.

Matthews was killed. Two other teenagers were injured, one of them seriously.

The 15-year-old took something from Matthews' pocket and then stole his designer sunglasses before he left with the four other youths, police said.

Police said the restaurant's security camera captured the incident and helped them identify the suspect, who was **arrested** Tuesday at his mother's home on Monte Vista.
