2 involved in teen's fatal shooting to be sentenced

Sentencing has been scheduled for two men who pleaded guilty in the 2005 fatal shooting of a Royal Oak teen.

Leon Treadwell, 22, of Detroit is to be sentenced Sept. 17 before Circuit Court Judge Fred Mester. He pleaded guilty last week to second-degree murder and possessing a firearm during a felony.

Kyle Belevender, 17, was shot multiple times. He "believed he'd be buying a pound of marijuana, but the suspects showed up to steal his money," Lt. Corrigan O'Donohue said.

Treadwell's accomplice, Michael Anderson, 23, is scheduled for an Oct. 8 sentencing before Mester. He pleaded guilty to second-degree murder in August.

Treadwell faces a minimum of 15 years in prison, while Anderson faces a minimum of 10 years, O'Donohue said.
