

WILLIAMS ALSO CHARGED IN '91 RAPE

Confessed serial killer Leslie Williams faces new charges **in the rape** of a Walled Lake woman and the assault and kidnapping of the boyfriend of one of the four teenagers Williams says he raped and killed.

Oakland County Prosecutor Richard Thompson issued warrants Thursday charging Williams **in** the April 28, 1991, **rape** of Walled Lake resident Theresa Burk and the Jan. 4 knifepoint abduction of Lucas Briningstool **in** Milford's Central Park.

Williams pulled Briningstool, then 15, and his girlfriend Cynthia Jones from Briningstool's car and tied Briningstool to a tree with plastic handcuffs. He later led police to Jones' shallow grave near Milford.

Williams has confessed to being the ski-masked **man** who raped Burk, then 21, at knifepoint on the side of a road after she finished work at a Walled Lake restaurant.

Williams, 38, has also confessed to the **rapes** and slayings of Kami Villanueva of South Lyon and Michelle and Melissa Urbin of Tyrone Township. He said he plans to plead guilty to all four killings. The penalty is mandatory life **in** prison without parole.

He has also told police he raped three other women who did not report the assaults. Thompson said it was important to charge Williams with all the crimes he has committed.

"We feel he should be held accountable for every crime he has committed," Thompson said. "We want the women who did not report their assaults to know that we're interested **in** pursuing those cases. We hope they will come forward."

Burk, 22, who has spoken out on her ordeal, said Williams' prosecution will not make up for her suffering. She won't sleep without a night-light **in** her room and is afraid to stand outside her front door alone.

"When he was raping me that night, he killed a big part of my life," she said.

Also Thursday, police confirmed that the picture of a woman found **in** Williams' wallet was, as Williams claimed, attached to a box of tools at a Massachusetts company before it was shipped to Harbormaster marine store **in** Livonia, where Williams worked.
