Wilson guilty of slayings

DETROIT -- Charles (Little Charlie) **Wilson** was convicted in Recorder's Court Thursday of four counts of second-degree murder and a count of assault with intent to murder for his role as a gunman in the "Hart Street **Massacre** ."

Wilson also was convicted of armed robbery and using a firearm in the commission of a felony.

Killed Aug. 10 in the **drug** -related robbery at a house on Hart Street were Charles Hampton and his wife Pamela, both 21; Charlie Grace, 33, and Herman Robinson, 12. Lawrence Heath, 17, was shot in the back, but survived.

Sentencings are set next month for **Wilson** and Derrick (Papa) Dupree, who was convicted Tuesday of armed robbery in the slaying.

The jury was still debating the fate of another defendant, Darnell (Fats) Wiley. A fourth man, Anthony (Pretty Tony) Goodman is awaiting trial.
