**IN COURT Woman is sentenced in arson that killed 2** A Detroit **woman** who set a building ablaze because of a drug debt pleaded guilty to two counts of second-degree murder and was **sentenced** Wednesday to 25-50 years **in** prison. Louretha Morgan, 46, set the blaze Jan. 9 at a 46-unit complex on Merton near Palmer Park **in** Detroit. **Killed** were Derrick Wilbourn Jr., 3, and Robin Abraham, 19, who lived **in** separate apartments.

Wayne County Circuit Judge Deborah Thomas handed down the sentence Wednesday. Morgan pleaded guilty April 19. Police said Morgan was trying to scare another **woman** who lived **in** the building because the **woman** allegedly owed Morgan \$10 for a rock of crack cocaine. Neither of the fire's victims was the intended target, police said. By Ben
