### **Home invaders face life terms**

Two members of a gang that robbed and shot up drug houses **face life prison terms** after being convicted Friday of racketeering and conspiracy.

A federal jury deliberated about two days before finding Yon Snyder, 31, and Christopher Allen Jr., 23, guilty for their part in 38 robberies committed by the **Home Invaders** gang from May 1993 to November 1994. The trial lasted 12 days before U.S. District Judge Patrick Duggan in Detroit.

Two others, Edward Bell, 24, and Mario Powell, 23, were acquitted of all charges. Snyder, whose bond was revoked after the verdict, will appeal, said his lawyer, Patrick Cleary. Curtis Williams, Allen's lawyer, could not be reached.
