

3 men charged in rape of girl, 13 - Teen says she was driven from Flint by man she met on Web, then attacked at gunpoint.

DETROIT -- Three men were charged Thursday in connection with the case of a 13-year-old Flint girl who said she was raped by several men on Detroit's west side March 13.

Wayne County Prosecutor Kym Worthy on Thursday charged **Andre Robinson**, 37; Aaron Robinson, 40; and Kenneth Richmond, 19, all of Detroit.

Andre Robinson and Aaron Robinson, who are cousins, have been charged with first-degree criminal sexual conduct, a felony punishable by up to life in prison, and one count of third-degree criminal sexual conduct, a felony that carries a maximum penalty of 15 years in prison.

Richmond was charged with two counts of third-degree criminal sexual conduct, a 15-year felony, and is being sought.

The Robinsons face arraignment today. They were to be formally charged Thursday but the paperwork was not ready, police said.

Police arrested the Robinsons, Tuesday at a home in the 20200 block of Lindsay the same day the 13-year-old girl and her mother filed a police report. The victim later identified the arrested men as two of her attackers.

The girl told police that she came in contact with the suspects as a result of online conversations earlier this year.

She reported that she met a man on the Internet who picked her up in Flint and drove her some 70 miles to Detroit, police said.

She said they went to a house, where she said she was raped at gunpoint and later taken to another location in the Seven Mile and Greenfield area.

Additional arrests are expected in the investigation, police said.
