Woman to stand trial in girl's shooting death

A Detroit woman accused of shooting and killing an 18-month old girl last month was bound over for trial in Wayne County Circuit Court on an involuntary manslaughter charge.

Judge B. Pennie Millender of the 36th District Court ruled after Monday's preliminary examination that there was probable cause for **Tonya Hardaway**, 46, to stand trial. She also is charged with using a firearm in the commission of a felony. If convicted, **Hardaway** could face up to 15 years in prison.

Hardaway is accused of shooting Dai'Janell Clark on March 28 as she slept in a bed at **Hardaway**'s home on Detroit's east side.
