Driver in crash tried to run out, police say

ROMULUS — The **driver** of a pickup who caused a **crash** on Interstate 94 that left one person dead on Friday **tried to** flee before being restrained by passing motorists, police say.

Michigan State Police said the **driver** was taken **to** a hospital, along with other passengers **in** his pickup, and will be arrested upon release.

Ibrahim Kadhum Alkazaihi, 41, of Detroit was pronounced dead at the scene after the eastbound pickup lost control and crossed the median, crashing into three other cars. The occupants of the other two vehicles involved **in** the **crash** were treated at the scene and released.

The freeway reopened at 6:30 p.m.

The truck flipped over the northern guardrail and crossed all four westbound lanes before ending up **in** a ditch. Police say the **driver tried to** flee, but was restrained by passing motorists until police arrived. Police say they believe alcohol and/or drugs were involved **in** the accident.

Police are withholding the identity of the truck **driver** pending criminal charges.
