Sentence for drug leader

DETROIT -- Milton (Butch) Jones, 27, who says he was a founder and **leader** of the Young Boys Inc. heroin ring, was sentenced to 12 years in prison Tuesday by U. S. District Judge Ralph Guy Jr.

Jones, who pleaded guilty March 22 to conducting a continuing criminal enterprise, was sentenced as testimony ended in the trial of four other alleged members of Young Boys.

Before his surrender in March, Jones had been one of the state's most-hunted fugitives. Indicted Dec. 6 with 40 other alleged ring members, he dropped from sight while police rounded up the other suspects.

Sylvester (Seal) Murray, the other alleged top **leader**, is on trial with three other defendants before Guy on **drug** -conspiracy charges.
