Brawl at nightclub sends 4 to hospital

A fight broke out **at** a club in the Ramada Inn on 9 Mile and sent four people **to** Providence **Hospital** with injuries.

At 2:10 a.m. June 13, police responded to a call about the fight that began in Yesterday's Night Club in the hotel. Police said a 26-year-old Oak Park man heard another man yell a gang term about a group that hung around Puritan Street in Detroit.

They said he and three Southfield men -- a 25-year-old and two 26-year-olds -- were confronted by the man and his acquaintances. The group, mostly men in their 20s and 30s, then assaulted them, police said.

The men took the fight into the parking lot, but when police arrived, the four victims had already been taken **to** Providence **Hospital**, where they were later released.

Near the same hotel, **at** 3:15 a.m. June 13, a canine officer found a wad of bills totaling under \$200 in a road, according **to** Detective John Harris. Police are investigating **to** see if there is a link with the fight. {DISCLAIMER}
