

DETROIT MAN DIES AFTER LOSING CONTROL OF MOTORCYCLE

An evening ride turned deadly for a Detroit motorcyclist who investigators say lost control of the vehicle on Sunday night, leading to a four-bike crash in Ann Arbor Township.

Anthonne Marice Anderson, 43, of Detroit died at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital in Ann Arbor after the 6 p.m. crash on southbound U.S.-23, said Sgt. Tony Cuevas of the Michigan State Police this morning. According to witnesses, **Anderson** lost control just south of Plymouth Road, causing three of the other four Detroit motorcycle drivers with him to crash, too, Cuevas said.

Two were in stable condition at University of Michigan Hospital in Ann Arbor this morning. The third person immediately left the scene of the accident. Police intend to question him today, Cuevas added. Alcohol is not suspected to have been a factor in the crash, but police are awaiting tests to confirm that, he said.
