Reward for Young Boys chief info

DETROIT -- City police and the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration are offering a \$3,000 reward for information leading to the arrest of Kurt Napier, a Young Boys Inc. leader and accused murderer.

Napier, also known as "Kurt McGurk," was convicted this year on federal drug charges. He failed to show up for sentencing June 14 and is believed to be hiding in the Detroit area.

Napier, 19, was charged in June with murdering Joseph (Wamp) Brown the day after Brown testified on behalf of Raymond Peoples, who claims to have been a founder of the Young Boys gang. Napier also was charged with shooting at a police officer who was trying to arrest him.

The DEA said Napier should be regarded as "armed and extremely dangerous."
