2 sought for allegedly operating drug gangs

Authorities are seeking two men allegedly involved in the **Puritan Avenue** Boys drug **gang**, whose members are accused of using violence and intimidation to control a northwest Detroit neighborhood.

The men -- Rayshon (Boss) Braggs, 30, of Atlanta and Rory (Roy) Jones, 37, of Detroit -- were among eight people indicted Nov. 20 on federal charges of operating two major cocaine **gangs** in Detroit, Atlanta and Birmingham, Ala., since January 1990.

The other suspects have been arrested.

The two men might be living in Detroit or Atlanta, according to David Jacobson, spokesman for the Drug Enforcement Administration, which led the three-year investigation.
