13-year-old killed in Detroit drive-by shooting

Detroit police are investigating the **shooting** death of a **13-year-old** boy who was shot to death after masked gunmen riddled his home with bullets on Detroit's southwest side Sunday morning.

According to a report on WDIV-Channel 4, the victim was identified as Christian Sanchez, a student at The Academy of the Americas. According to Detroit police, the incident occurred at about 3 a.m. when three masked gunmen fired eight shots through the front door of the home in the 7000 block of St. John.

Sanchez was **killed** while his 19-year-old brother - whom police believe was the intended target of the **shooting** - received multiple wounds and is **in** critical condition at a local hospital. At this time police have no suspects **in** the **shooting**.
