

ARREST IN FOUR SLAYINGS

A week-long Detroit Police dragnet resulted **in** the **arrest** early Thursday of a man charged with the submachine gun killings of **four** members of a family **in** a Hart Street flat Aug. 10.

Charles (Little Charlie) Wilson Jr. was arrested at about 3 a.m. at an apartment **in** the 1800 block of East Grand Blvd.

Wilson and two others were charged **in** warrants issued a week ago with **four** counts of murder , assault with intent to murder, armed robbery and use of a firearm **in** a felony.

Wilson, first of the three to be arrested, had been the subject of a citywide search by officers from several police units. Police said that **in** the last week they arrested his close associates for lesser crimes **in** an attempt to get information on his whereabouts.

WILSON WAS arraigned Thursday before Detroit District Judge James Chylinski, who ordered him held **in** Wayne County Jail without bond pending a preliminary examination Nov. 26.

Still sought were Anthony Dwayne (Pretty Tony) Goodman, 24, and a third man, listed on the warrant only as a John Doe.

A fourth man, Derrick (Papa) Dupree, 28, already **in** jail for parole violation, also was named **in** the warrant and charged with armed robbery and use of a firearm **in** a felony.

POLICE SAID at least two .45-caliber submachine guns owned by Dupree were used **in** killing Charles (Rusty) Hampton, 25, and his wife, Pamela, 23, who lived **in** the upper flat **in** the 2200 block of Hart, and their visitors, Charlie Grace Jr., 33, a cousin, and Herman Robinson, 12, a nephew.

An 11-month-old baby was spared and a 17-year-old youth was injured **in** what was known **in** the neighborhood as a "weed house" where marijuana was sold.
